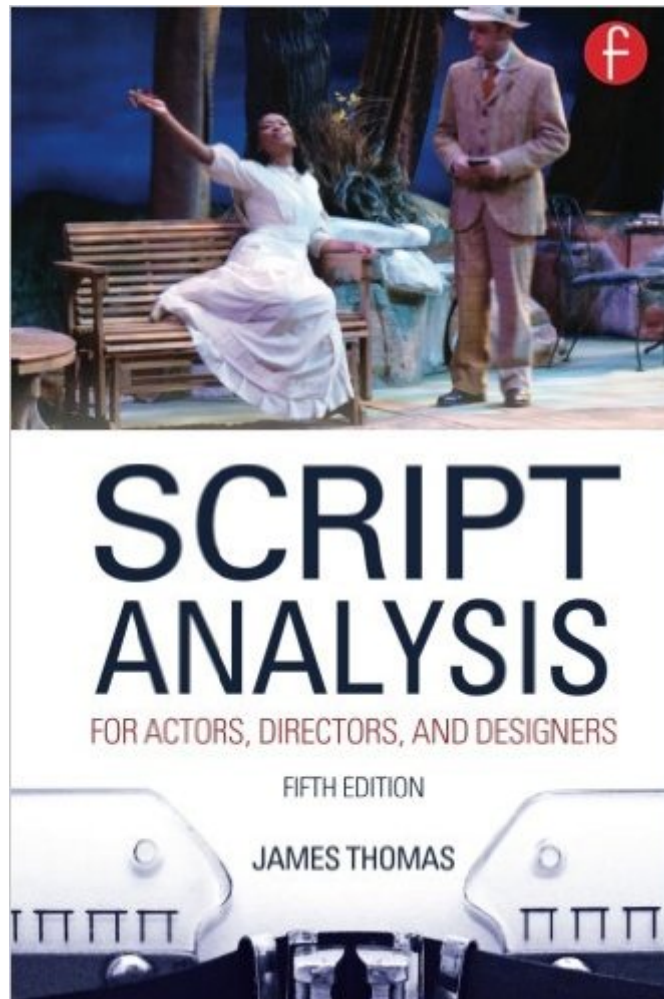


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# Script Analysis For Actors, Directors, And Designers

That said, I have a pretty thorough experience of working with this book as a student and as a teacher, and I have found it extremely useful. Thomas's careful, systematic approach provides numerous opportunities for discovery at different levels within the text of the script. And he does all of this with a focus on performance - how do you locate and communicate insights that will unlock the script for production?
