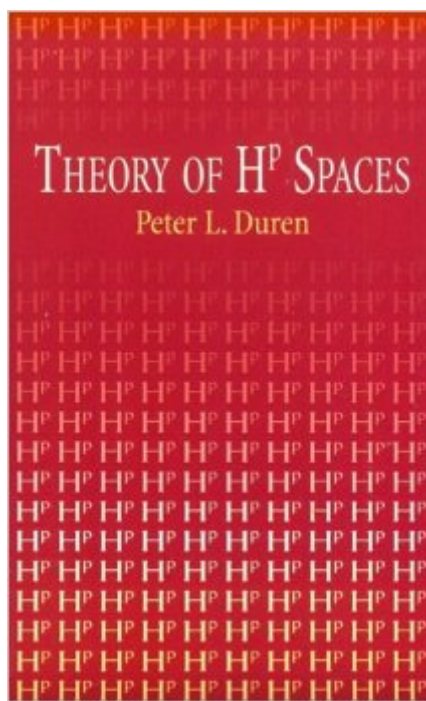


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Theory Of Hp Spaces



Synopsis

A blend of classical and modern techniques and viewpoints, this text examines harmonic and subharmonic functions, the basic structure of H_p functions, applications, conjugate functions, and mean growth and smoothness. 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The first edition of this book appeared about thirty years ago and unfortunately wasn't very popular as a textbook because of its limited availability. This new edition makes it possible for many readers (including me) to own it at last. The book is written from the viewpoint of classical analysis and is as fresh now as it was 30 years ago despite huge progress made in this area during the last decades. Both organization and selection of material is excellent and introduces the reader to one of the most beautiful mathematical theories created in 20th century. The author took his time and wrote a very informative Supplement. It not just covers the newest developments in the theory of Hardy spaces and problems solved in last thirty years, but also gives very good idea about newest directions which grew up from this theory. This book definitely should be recommended to any student who wants to specialize in the theory Banach spaces of analytic or harmonic functions.

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
